

AFFIDAVIT OF JAMES A. MOORE

Before me, the undersigned notary, on this day personally appeared James A. Moore, a person whose identity is known to me. Upon his oath, James A. Moore said as follows:

1. "My name is James A. Moore. I am more than 18 years of age, of sound mind, and capable of making this affidavit. The facts stated in this affidavit are within my personal knowledge and are true and correct.

2. I was employed in a part-time capacity for directing the music ministry at the First Baptist Church of Farmers Branch during part or all of the years 1968 and 1969, and during other years.


3. During part or all of years 1968 and 1969, the youth and education minister of the First Baptist Church of Farmers Branch was a man named Tommy Gilmore.

4. At some point during 1969, Tommy Gilmore came to me and expressed some concern. I do not remember the exact words he used, but he expressed concern about the possibility that some other member of the congregation may have seen him in a compromising position with Christa Brown.

5. At some point after that in 1969, Christa Brown began to cry during a piano lesson at the church. I was her piano teacher. I do not remember her exact words, but she told me something to the effect that she had an affair with Tommy Gilmore.


6. After that conversation with Christa Brown, I approached Tommy Gilmore and told him that if he did not leave, I would take the matter before the church. Within a few weeks after that, Tommy Gilmore left the First Baptist Church of Farmers Branch.

7. I did not then know the extent of the contact between Christa Brown and Tommy Gilmore or any details about the relationship."
